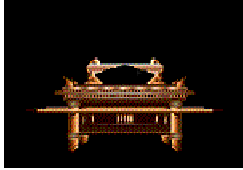

## Grand Chapter RAM, Michigan

### Companions

There are several proposed Amendments to the Red Book of Capitular Law being submitted this year. Most of them are planned to clean up the Law Book, while others will be new revisions.

One of the changes is to remove the stipulation that a Past Grand High Priest has to live in Michigan to be on the Jurisprudence Committee. With today's technologies any Companion is only a click away to get all the information and can be kept as informed, and in some cases more quickly, as one living in the state.

Another has to deal with how we pay our Representatives to General Grand Chapter. The cost to represent Michigan at General Grand Chapter is way more than Grand Chapter of Michigan pays. We budget \$450.00 each year for this endeavor. Let's pay our representatives at least that much to help cover part of their expenses. The General Grand Chapter only occurs once every three years. The top three Grand Officers, or their proxy, are required to attend and are given reimbursement of \$.12 per mile plus \$15.00 for expenses. Registration alone is \$150.00 which does not include any meals or lodging which is at least 2 if not 3 days.

Next has to do with changing the election of officers. I would like to see the election start at the Grand Royal Arch Captain. A six-year line is about what the other bodies are servicing. If a Companion is serious about being the Grand High Priest he can prepare for the job in six years. The Masters of the Veils should be appointed by the incoming Grand High Priest to serve *that year only*. It is not the intention of this amendment to start appointing the bottom of the line. It would shorten the line of succession and would continue to give the Companions of the State the opportunity to select from those running for Grand Honors whom they desire.

The Red Book Review Committee, I understand, also, has several Amendments which they will be proposing.

I propose the following change to the Red Book of Capitular Law.

Sec.128 B. 7 on page 38A, which reads as follows:

Jurisprudence Committee to consist of three Past Grand High Priests residing in the State of Michigan. The Jurisprudence Committee's duties shall be:

- a. Review all Chapter By-laws received from the subordinate chapters. See that errors are corrected and then send to the Grand High Priest for his review and approval.
- b. Review all permissions and dispensations.
- c. Assist the Grand High Priest with matters relative to consolidation.
- d. Assist the Grand High Priest with any questions relating to Capitular law.
- e. Report annually to the Grand Chapter.

To read as follows:

Jurisprudence Committee to consist of three Past Grand High Priests. The Jurisprudence Committee's duties shall be:

- a. Review all Chapter By-laws received from the subordinate chapters. See that errors are corrected and then send to the Grand High Priest for his review and approval.
- b. Review all permissions and dispensations.
- c. Assist the Grand High Priest with matters relative to consolidation.
- d. Assist the Grand High Priest with any questions relating to Capitular Law.
- e. Report annually to the Grand Chapter.

Reason for change:

- a. The original rationale for the Past Grand High Priest to live in Michigan is no longer valid.

At the time this legislation was originally written the time that it took with others within the state was hours, days and sometimes weeks compared to now.

With today's technology most all Past Grand High Priests are only a click away with E-mail and internet service and with the use of cell phone communication, which many carry with them, and are kept informed of what is happening in Michigan Royal Arch Masonry.
