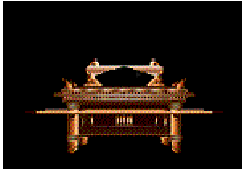

Proposed Amendments to Grand Chapter Law:

Amendment No. 1. Amend Sec. 128 #7 to permit Jurisprudence Members to reside outside of the State of Michigan. (Printed in the April Issue of the Triple Tau.)

Amendment No. 2. Amend Sec. 20 Representatives to General Grand Chapter. To help better offset the expenses incurred by the representatives to the General Grand Chapter Session. (Printed in the April Issue of the Triple Tau.)

Amendment No. 3. Amend Sec. 9 Offices Vacated by Removal from State. To clean up the Red Book was (Printed in the May Issue of the Triple Tau.)

Amendment No 4. Amend Sec. 6 B, Sec. 7 and Sec 116 shorten the elective line of the Grand Chapter from 9 to 6 years. (Printed in the April Issue of the Triple Tau.)

The remainder of the Proposed Amendments that were received into the Office of the Grand Chapter prior to the deadline for submission and consideration for this Grand Chapter Session will be printed in this the June Issue in the Order of Submission. The printing of these Amendments will be considered as the first reading thereof.

Amendment No. 5. Sec. 135. Per Capita Tax and Fees to Grand Chapter

which currently reads:

Each Chapter shall pay annually to the Grand Chapter, before the fifteenth day of May the following sums:

- A. For each member in good standing on the Chapter rolls of April 30th, Ten Dollars and Seventy Five cents (\$10.75). Each Chapter shall receive exemptions for the following members:

The Secretary if not a prepaid member.

Life Members prior to Jul 1, 1997.

Members whose dues have been remitted for charitable consideration, but not to exceed 10 percent of those paying per capita reported on the immediately preceding Annual Report.

Prepaid members. (2001)

- B. For each Withdrawal or Demit granted during the year, the same amount as is required in paragraph A of this section. (1998)
- C. Any sum remitted to Grand Chapter in excess of these amounts shall be refunded to the subordinate Chapter not later than September 16 of that calendar year. (2001)

Change to read:

Sec. 135. Per Capita Tax and Fees to Grand Chapter

Each Chapter shall pay annually to the Grand Chapter, before the fifteenth day of May the following sums:

- A. For each member in good standing on the Chapter rolls of April 30th, **Fifteen Dollars and Seventy Five cents (\$15.75)** Each Chapter shall receive exemptions for the following members:

The secretary if not a prepaid member.

Life members prior to July 1, 1997.

Members whose dues have been remitted for charitable consideration, but not to exceed 10 percent of those paying per capita reported on the immediately preceding Annual Report.

Prepaid members. (2001)

- A. For each Withdrawal or Demit granted during the year, the same amount as is required in paragraph A of this section. (1998)
- B. Any sum remitted to Grand Chapter in excess of these amounts shall be refunded to the subordinate Chapter not later than September 16 of that calendar year. (2001)

RATIONALE;

This section was written in 1997. The value of the dollar in 2009 is only 75% of its 1997 value. Our membership has dropped from 8100 members to around 4200. This means that in 1997 the Grand Chapter had an actual income of Eight Five Thousand (\$85,000.00) in per capita. The year 2009 our per capita income was roughly thirty three thousand eight hundred dollars (\$33,800.00) in 1997 dollars. This increase will allow the Grand Chapter to elevate its income to Sixty six thousand dollars (\$66,000.00). In order to keep up with the cost of living. These figures do not compensate for life members before 1997 that pay no per capita.

Proposed Amendments to Grand Chapter Law

Amendment No. 6.

Sec. 7. Election of Officers.

AS READS

At each Annual convocation of Grand Chapter, the officers of the Grand Chapter shall be elected by ballot, except the Grand Chaplain, who may be appointed by the Grand High Priest-elect following his election, otherwise the election will include the office of the Grand Chaplain. The elective officers, including the Grand Chaplain, whether appointed or elected, are to hold their office until the next Annual Convocation, and until their successors shall have been duly elected and installed.

IS AMMENDED TO READ

At each Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter, the officers of the Grand Chapter elected by ballot except the Grand Chaplain who shall be appointed by the Grand High Priest-elect following his election. The officers, whether appointed or elected, are to hold their office until the next Annual Convocation, until their successors shall have been duly installed.

REASON: This amendment is to clarify who are elected or appointed Grand Officers

Amendment No. 7.

Sec. 135. Per Capita Tax and Fees to Grand Chapter

AS READS

Each Chapter shall pay annually to Grand Chapter, before the fifteenth day of the following sums:

A. For each member in good standing on the Chapter Rolls of April 30th, Ten Dollars and Seventy-Five cents (\$10.75). Each Chapter shall receive exemptions for the following members:

IS AMENDED TO READ

Each Chapter shall pay annually to Grand Chapter, before the Fifteenth of May, the following sums:

A. For each member in good standing on the Chapter Rolls of April 30th, the Per Capita tax will increase \$1.00 each year for the next ten years, from 2010 thru 2019, from the current Ten Dollars and Seventy five cents. Each Chapter shall receive exemptions for the following members:

REASONS: Our Grand Chapter cannot continue to serve our Chapters with the financial situation that we are currently in. We have several new programs to present to the members and need help with materials and travel.

Amendment No. 8. Grand High Priest to Appoint Committees Unless Otherwise Ordered by Grand Chapter

B. Standing Committees

(This is a new "Standing Committee")

13. Red Book Review Committee to consist of three (3) Past Grand High Priests whose duty shall be:

a. To review all Grand High Priests rulings and all legislation as submitted to the Grand Chapter to insure that it is written properly is clearly understood as to the intent and is assigned to the proper Section Number and location in the Red Book, then send the same to the Jurisprudence committee for their review.

b. To review the Red Book of Capitular Law each year and submit all Past Grand High Priests rulings that have been in effect for a period of seven (7) years to the Jurisprudence Committee and, if found to still be appropriate, submit them to Grand Chapter for final Approval to become permanent law of the Grand Chapter.

Reason

To insure that all legislation and Grand high Priest's rulings are properly written, are clear as to the intent and that they are assigned to the proper Section Number and location in the Red Book. This Committee will then track all Grand High Priest rulings to make sure that they are reviewed and if necessary, submitted for permanent approval after they have been in effect for seven (7) years.

Amendment No. 8.

Sec.251. Reinstatement of standing.

AS READS

In case any Chapter shall cease to exist, except for the reason of consolidation, anyone who was at any time a member of such Chapter, and who at the time of termination of such Chapter charter stood under the sentence of suspension for non payment of dues or who holds a certificate of withdrawal of membership from such Chapter, may petition Grand Chapter for reinstatement of his Chapter status.

"For this purpose, a petition, substantially in form now provided for reinstatement of membership in a subordinate Chapter, shall be filed with the Grand Secretary at least thirty days before the Annual convocation, whereupon the Grand High Priest shall appoint a committee of three, who shall conduct an investigation and report to Grand Chapter at the forthcoming Convocation, and at which time said petition shall be brought on for consideration and determination.

Unless the yeas and nays are ordered, the vote of Grand Chapter shall be by a show of hands, and two-thirds required to reinstate. **Provided, however,** that when a petition for reinstatement of standing shall be received any time up to three months prior to the date of the Annual Convocation, the Grand High Priest is authorized to approve reinstatement only after receipt of recommendation from the investigating committee”.

If such Chapter status be by said Grand Chapter reinstated, the Grand Secretary shall be authorized to issue a certificate of good standing to such reinstated Companion under the same terms and conditions and with like effect as provided in Section 122A.

IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS

Section 251 of the current Red Book of Capitular Law is deleted and Replaces as reads below.

IS AMENDED TO READ

Sec. 251 Reinstatement of Standing.

A. When a Chapter shall cease to exist, except for the reason of Consolidation, anyone who was at any time a member of such Chapter and who, at the termination of such Chapter charter, stood under the sentence of suspension for non-payment of dues or who holds a certificate of withdrawal of membership from such Chapter, may petition Grand Chapter for reinstatement of his Chapter status. For this purpose, a Petition, substantially in form now provided for reinstatement of membership in a subordinate Chapter, shall be filed with the Grand Secretary at least thirty (30) days prior to the Annual convocation of Grand Chapter. The Grand High Priest shall then appoint a committee of three (3) who shall conduct an investigation and report their findings to him. If found satisfactory, the Grand High Priest may approve reinstatement and report his actions to the Grand Chapter for ratification.

B. If reinstatement is approved by Grand Chapter, the Grand Secretary shall be authorized to issue a “certificate of good standing” to such reinstated Companion under the terms and conditions as provided by Grand Chapter law.

REASON: We must correct the current Red Book so that the new Red Book will be correct as printed.

RESOLUTION:

Be it resolved that the Degree Ritual of the Past Masters Degree as it is now written, be deleted and replaced by the obligation and the Past Master Allegory as written in the Past Masters Degree Book.

It would be rewritten as follow:

Open Lodge in the Past Masters Degree

S. D. Bring the Candidate(s) in, seat him in the North Side of the Lodge

H.P. Instruct candidate(s) in the signs and password of this degree.

Originally when Royal Arch Masonry was under the government of symbolic lodge, the royal arch degree was always conferred on Past Masters. It was a regulation that no one could receive it unless he had previously presided as the Master of a lodge.

The Confirming of the royal Arch on those who actually had been Master of a lodge would cause a membership to be so low that the degree would be of no use. Therefore a way had to be found to pass the chair, this degree provides the way to do so.

The conferring of this degree and this brief explanation of the reason does not make you an actual Past Master, but allows you to pass the chair.

The Obligation

S.D. In the Allegory which will follow, you will represent a faithful craftsman whose name was Levi, imagine yourself to be Levi. As the drama unfolds and go with him in spirit, as he speaks and acts for you.

The Past Master Allegory is presented as written

At the end of line 20 page 148, seat each companion in the seat of honor of King Solomon with the aid of the Past Masters grip, invest him with the masters jewel. (Remove jewel, return him to his seat)
