## *York Rite Masonry in Brazil*

On November 1, 2006 Ann and I left Miami, Fla for Rio DeJaneiro Brazil for their Grand York Rite Session. Being the Representative from Michigan to Brazil, I received an invitation to attend their Session. The Grand Correspondence Secretary Rui de Silva met us at the airport. We were taken to a hotel, that was not the original hotel, because some Muslim group found out dignitaries were coming from the US and were displeased on us being there. They did not want this group to know that our hotel was changed. We had military and civilian guards with us at all times.

The Session was opened on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of November and lasted until the 4<sup>th</sup>. This was only the second Grand Chapter Session. They received their Charter three years ago. The York Rite bodies meet tri-annually. The session was held in the oldest Blue Lodge in Brazil This Lodge dates back to 1805. Masonry grew very much like ours did under George Washington. All of the first members of the Brazilian Lodge were highly regarded leaders of the Country. This still holds true to this day. A large part of the Brazilian Parliament are members of the fraternity. One, of many things that impressed me was that there was standing room only in the Grand Chapter Room and balcony. There were 7 foreign York Rite Dignitaries in attendance. We were introduced and sat in the East with the Presiding Officer.

It is unbelievable how the Grand Chapter has grown in Brazil. In 2003 there were only 3 Chapter which has grown to 33 in 2006 with 3 new Chapters given their charters at this session. One of the new Chapters was named after the General Grand King of the General Grand Chapter, Ed Harrison. This was a big surprise to all. The Chapter business was concluded on the first day.

The DeMolay are very active in Brazil. They were the ushers and honor guards for the ladies in attendance.

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day, the Grand Council was given their Charter from Bud Hines, the General Grand Master of the Grand Council International.

That evening we were received in a Special Session of the Parliament held in the House

Companions, you know as well as I, that one important way to get regular attendance by Companions at meetings is to COMMUNICATE. Information stimulates interest. They need information about Chapter activities, upcoming events, status and welfare of members, etc. Information stimulates interest. Without information, the opposite is true. The next step can be withdrawal or dropping for non-payment of dues.

Certainly many forms of communication can be used. When the Secretary sends out dues notices, he can request an e-mail address, if one exists. Short e-mail, "snail" mail the written word on paper is an effective tool.

Let's look at some content for letters to members; inform (or remind) members of activities in the future, particularly if it's an event for nicer weather, like a golf tournament. Do let everyone know who has moved from the area, or back in. Letters to those who have moved recently tend to make them continue to feel a part of the chapter. Name those who are ill or homebound. Encourage a personal visit. Can you think of a more thoughtful way to communicate than meeting face to face?

Inform the Editor of the Triple Tau of your activities. Men in other Chapters are interested and may well like to pay you a visit. Certainly let those in other Chapters know of your need for assistance in presenting degrees.

It's time, Companions to revitalize our Chapters. Be creative. Discuss how you might use the time saved from not reading minutes. Encourage your High Priest and Education Chairman to seek out and present material for you. COMMUNICATE. COMMUNICATE. COMMUNICATE.

In the Antarctic expedition of 1933-35, sixty of the eighty-two members were Freemasons and on Feb. 5, 1935, they established First Antarctic Lodge No. 777 of New Zealand constitution.

We are always looking for new ideas from the Companions in helping to raise funds to make our Grand Chapter Foundation grow.

Instead of coming up with another gimmick for the Companions to try and sell, we are asking for donations plain and simple. If each of the 62 Chapters were to donate \$25.00 we could make \$1,550.00 immediately. Of course we could raise more if the larger Chapters donated larger sums of money. Also individuals could take it upon themselves to make further donations.

What it comes down to is how much does your Royal Arch Membership mean to you? If you believe as I do, that its worth much more than I can ever pay, invest in our future and give what you can afford. 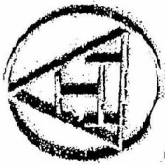
